The third major era of Egyptian history is called the New Kingdom, it consists of the eighteenth, nineteenth and twentieth dynasties. Ahmose I expelled the Hyksos and founded the eighteenth dynasty. A notable figure of the New Kingdom was the female pharaoh, Hatshepsut. She built New Temples and monuments throughout Egypt. Her period of rule is known for its peace and prosperity. The reign of Thutmose III is a watershed in Egypt's progress toward empire. Akheriston established the worship of the sun god Aton and moved the capital to Amaina.

The period of the renetcenth and twentieth dynasties is referred to as the Ramesside age because most of its pharaults bere the personal name Ramesses. Kings moved the royal residence to the eastern Delta, Egypt had implemented a policy of armed accupation in Asia under Sety I and Ramesses II. The wars of this period were fought with the powerful Near East Empires, such as the Hitties, the Mitarian and the Assorians. During the twentieth dynasty Ramesses III fought against the Sea peoples. The New Kingdom came to an end during the reign of Ramesses XI.

In front of the Entrance Pylon of Ramses II, he placed six colossal states of himself, four standing and two seated. He also exected two grante obalisks insurbed with his name and titles one is now in the Place de la Concente in Patis. The vertical grooves in the front section of each tower of the pylon were for the insertion of standards. The square openings above them nest braces, both lowers were decorated with relieves of Ramses. Buttle of Kiedesh They are not in good condition and are somewhat difficult to see. On the right-hand tower are relieves of the Egyptian cump with Ramses II consulting with his military campanders. On the left-hand tower he charges the enemy, managing to keep them engaged until rendforcements arrive.
